

- 1.) The Commission reached a unanimous conclusion that the area of the Marjan peninsula with the Marjan Park Forest has an outstanding value as a whole, and that with its landscape, horticultural, ambient and cultural-historical values it represents an outstanding value for the city of Split and its citizens. The Commission drafting the Historic Core of Split Management Plan and the Palace of Diocletian Management Plan proposes to the Ministry of Culture that the region of the Marjan Peninsula with the Marjan Park Forest in Split be registered with UNESCO as the Buffer Zone to the cultural-historic core, Zone A, of the City of Split.
  
- 3.) The decision is brought that the Commission will ask the Mayor of the City of Split to nominate the persons authorised to contact the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Croatia, the Croatian Commission for UNESCO, in order to request free technical assistance from UNESCO with the drafting of the Management Plan.
